Employment Opportunity Paid-On-Call Firefighter (Volunteer)

The Carleton Place Fire Department is accepting applications for the position of Paid-On-Call Firefighter. (Volunteer)

The Carleton Place Fire Department is comprised of a full-time Fire Chief, full-time Deputy Fire Chief, and a full-time Assistant Chief, 2 full-time Fire Prevention Officers, a full-time Administration Assistant/CEMC, and paid-on-call firefighters. (Volunteer) We serve properties covering the town of Carleton Place. We also provide fire protection services to neighbouring municipalities through Automatic and Mutual Aid Agreements.

Firefighters are required to respond to calls for emergency assistance including but not limited to fires, medical emergencies, motor vehicle accidents, water/ice rescue and hazardous material incidents.

Training is a critical component of being a firefighter. After successfully completing an initial approx. 120-hour recruitment training course, each member is expected to attend a minimum of four hours of training per month, there are also numerous training opportunities held at various locations and times during the year.

In this paid on-call, volunteer position, you will be provided with extensive training and have opportunities to obtain certification in fire prevention, firefighting, and rescue activities. You will participate alongside other firefighters in stressful, physically, and mentally challenging situations which can be inherently dangerous, for which you will receive specialized training.

In addition to emergency response and training, paid-on-call firefighters participate in local festivals, fundraising functions, public education, and other community events. Taking on the challenge of becoming a paid-on-call firefighter (Volunteer) requires a significant commitment but the experience of being an active member within your community is extremely rewarding.

The minimum qualifications to be considered for this position are as follows:

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Provide an acceptable criminal records check When offer is presented.
- Be able to pass a comprehensive medical exam.
- Successfully complete the written & physical tests
- Hold a valid Ontario G class driver's license (or equivalent), with no more than six (6) demerit points accumulated within 6 months of the employment.

- Must obtain a DZ within the first 36 months at own cost.
- Provide a current Driver's Abstract When offer is presented.
- Hold a Secondary School Diploma (Grade 12) or academic equivalent diploma by the application <u>deadline of May 9, 2024.</u>
- Must have or be currently enrolled in an IFSAC OR PROBOARD NFPA 1001 Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications, Level I certification program, or/and must attend and successfully complete our in-house training.
- Possess a minimum 20/30 corrected vision with color and peripheral vision. appropriate for the position of firefighter When offer is presented.

Applications for this position shall be done by completion of the Paid-On-Call Firefighter (Volunteer) Recruitment Package, with supporting documentation. Applications shall be submitted and may be considered for further involvement in the selection process. Only those candidates who are selected for further consideration will be contacted. Successful applications will commence employment on the dates indicated or otherwise agreed to and should be prepared to undertake the time commitment necessary for this position.

Application Deadline: May 9, 2024, 2:00 PM Start Date: June 4, 2024

Job Requirements:

In addition to responding to emergency calls, other firefighter tasks include but are not limited to:

- Attending all meetings and training sessions regularly
- Assisting with fire prevention and public education activities
- Following Carleton Place Fire Department policies and procedures
- Regularly returning to the fire station after calls to clean equipment and ensure vehicles are ready for the next alarm.
- Maintaining records of attendance at alarms and training activities
- Cleaning and maintaining protective equipment to ensure it is ready for use.
- Participating in training activities and serving on committees as elected or appointed.
- Representing the fire department at various community events and festivals

Of Importance to Note:

- Responding to emergencies, on-going training, and community involvement requires a tremendous amount of time and commitment. It may require you to respond in the middle of the night, or during family activities.
- Success in the position of paid-on-call firefighter (Volunteer) is greatly attributed to the on-going support of family and friends.
- On a yearly basis you may attend approximately 48 hours of training, and 170-220 emergency calls.
- All Carleton Place firefighters must maintain a minimum attendance of 75% for regular monthly training and 50% response to fire calls to maintain employment.



PAID-ON-CALL FIREFIGHTER (Volunteer) RECRUITMENT PROCESS

The recruitment process consists of six (6) stages. Each stage is described in more detail in the following pages. At the conclusion of each stage, it shall be decided which candidates may proceed to the next stage. Stage #3 to #5 will be conducted at 15 Coleman St. Carleton Place fire hall.

STAGE 1 - ADVERTISEMENT

The Carleton Place Fire Department shall advertise using various methods. Interested candidates will be invited to apply for a Paid-On-Call Firefighter position.

STAGE 2 - APPLICATION REVIEW

A complete resume and required documents required at the point of application. Candidates must verify all qualifications with supporting documentation including photocopies of all certificates, diplomas, transcripts, etc.

STAGE 3 – Orientation night – applicants will be contacted

We will host an orientation night for you and your partner to discuss the expectations of being a Paid-On-Call/volunteer Firefighter. DATE & TIME: May 14, 2024, 1900 hrs

STAGE 4 – TESTING - applicants will be contacted

The Practical Physical Fitness test and the knowledge test are designed to gauge the candidate's physical and mental fitness and basic knowledge to meet the requirements of the job. Candidates must pass all tests to be considered for a position. See the Practical Fitness Testing Release for in Appendix "A" for details of the tests.

Practical Fitness Testing release forms must be signed prior to fitness tests.

DATE & TIME: May 21, 2024, 1800-2100 hrs.

"Appendix A" – Job Related Physical Fitness Test – This form must be signed by candidate prior to undergoing Practical Fitness Testing.

STAGE 5 – VERBAL INTERVIEW - applicants will be contacted

Candidates who are successful at the physical/written testing will be considered for an interview. The interview is not designed to test the candidate's technical knowledge, but rather allows for the opportunity to further assess the candidate's suitability in other areas. **DATE & TIME: May 27 & 28, 2024, between 0830-1630 hrs**

STAGE 6 - SELECTION AND APPOINTMENT

Based on information that is obtained from the entire process, the selection committee shall choose a suitable candidate(s). The successful candidate(s) will be offered the position of probationary paid-on-call firefighter.

(Medical assessment may be required)

STAGE 7 - MEDICAL ASSESSMENT AND EYE EXAMINATION

Medical Assessment and Eye Examination

Candidate may be required to undertake a complete medical exam at the Town's schedule.

Job Related Physical Fitness Test

Job related practical skills: Modified CPAT test All physical tests will be done with 40 LBS weight vest worn.

- 1. Stairs climb: 6 times in total with a 2.5 hose on your shoulder.
- 2. Hose drag, pull 1 ½ inch dry hose over your shoulder 50 feet, then drop to at least one knee and pull 50 feet must stay in designated box.
- 3. Equipment carry, take 2 saws off a raised table one at a time touch the ground walk 50 feet around the cone and 50 feet back pacing the saws one at a time back on the table.
- 4. Ladder set and raise- 2 times.(210)
- 5. Forcible entry move truck tire with a sledgehammer 18 inches.
- 6. Hose lift pull a 2 ¹/₂ inch hose to the top railing and over 2 times.
- 7. Rescue, drag the mannequin 35 feet around the cone 35 feet back, the mannequin must be dragged until it crosses the marked finish line.
- 8. Hose pull tower, pull hose with weight plates off the ground and lower 5 times four sets (Weight 70 LBS) under control.

Please Note

All physical testing performed in gym attire.

We encourage you to research the above skills to prepare for testing.


