                 Topic                Amendment to By-law 83-2005 (Taxi By-law)

**SUMMARY**

Ontario Regulation 191/11 (the Integrated Accessibility Standards) of the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 is scheduled to take effect as of the later of July 1, 2011 and the date it is filed. The Regulation covers three Standards, that of Information and Communications, Employment and Transportation.

Section 80(1) of the approved Transportation Standard requires municipalities to ensure that:

“owners and operators of taxi cabs are prohibited

- a)      from charging a higher fare or an additional fee for persons with disabilities that for persons without disabilities for the same trip; and
- b)      from charging a fee for the storage of mobilities aids or mobility assistive devices.”

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

THAT By-law No. 83-2005 be amended to incorporate the requirements of Section 80(1) of the Transportation Standards for taxi licensing.
